STAGES

<p>8:00 - 10:00 Setting the Stage Current Knowledge</p>	<p>Before any solution can be formulated, explored, or launched, there must be a thorough analysis of the past and current strategies, models, and best practices used to address the social issue.</p> <p>Participants will hear from thought leaders summarizing key concepts pulled from: Education for Health Research Articles; Practitioner Idea Publications; White Papers; and Expert Symposiums on Social Accountability; Population Health; Community Approaches to serve and engage Specialized Communities; and Inter-Professional/MultiDisciplinary Education.</p>
<p>10:00 - 12:00 Idea Formation Prototyping</p>	<p>Participants will brainstorm individually and in small groups, but topic issued, their unique idea that addresses current deficiencies or challenges. Small groups within each topic area will select their best idea and develop a prototype to explore and test with other global thought leaders.</p>
<p>1:00 - 3:00 Collective Design Prototype Testing</p>	<p>Upon completion of a prototype participants will individually test the idea with other thought leaders and then reconvene to produce a refined prototype. Participants will present the refine prototype to the large group for final feedback and further refinement.</p>
<p>3:00 - 5:00 Consensus Building Policy and Economic Strategies</p>	<p>All groups will reconvene to share their collective ideas mapping out strategy and policy recommendations on Inter-Professional; Training and Capacity Building; and Institutional Government Adoption for Social Accountability; Population Health; and Community Approaches to Engage and Serve Specialized Populations.</p> <p>Participants will collectively design and create recommended global language for institutions and/or governments to consider.</p>
